

Viewing the Health Summary

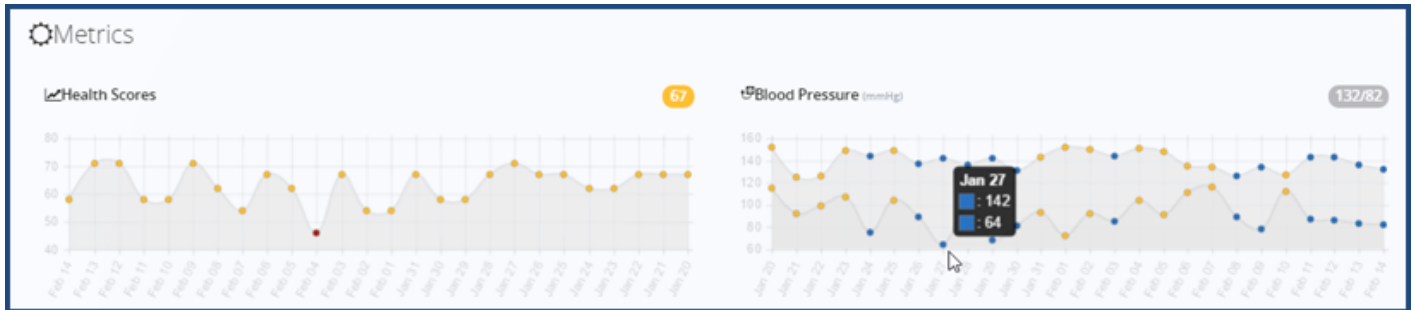
On the Health Summary tab, you can view detailed information about a patient. The order of the sections and which sections appear is configurable by a system administrator.

1. On the **Patients** page, click in the Patient Header of the patient you want to view.
2. Click the **Health Summary** tab.

The **Patient Health Summary** page appears.

The page consists of the following sections:

Metrics: The **Metrics** section includes line chart summaries of a patient's health indexes and biometrics readings over time. The x-axis shows the time period and the y-axis shows the reading or health score of the patient. You can see the current reading in the top right corner of each section. The current reading and the dots in the chart are color coded to the related alert level (for example, red is high alert and yellow is medium alert). To view a specific time period's reading, hover over any dot in the chart.



Flowsheet: The **Flowsheet** section includes all the readings and the date they were taken. If the biometric reading is above the normal threshold, the data will appear in the applicable alert level color (for example, red is high alert and yellow is for medium alert).
